



THE NORTHWEST CAMPUS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

This scholarship is limited to covering costs associated with tuition, books, and fees. It is meant to be a supplemental scholarship, applied for only after other funding sources have been considered, for students residing in the Bering Strait region. First priority will be given to students enrolled into a degree program. Students who are working to upgrade skills for certification or for on-the-job advancement will be given second priority. Third priority is given to students taking courses that develop knowledge and skills relating to the Bering Straits region. Final priority is given to students taking general interest courses.

Qualifications: To be eligible, students must demonstrate financial need and provide proof that an attempt was made to seek out funding from other sources. Students must also have at least a 2.0 GPA to be considered for this scholarship.

Instructions: Fill out the bottom of this form and turn it in with the following scholarship materials:

1. **Personal Budget Information:** Complete the attached sheet indicating your expenses and income. Choose whichever designator is easiest for you to complete the form (i.e., per hour, per week, per month, per year, etc.).
2. **Letter of Intent:** Attach a brief letter explaining what class you are interested in taking, why you wish to take the course, and what you hope to get out of it.
