Please let me know as soon as possible if you need to cease work and/or your project for BLM Idaho or NIFC JFSP has been affected by COVID-19. See exceptions provided below:

- Flexibility with SAM registration
- Flexibility with Application Deadlines
- No-cost extensions on expiring awards
- Abbreviated non-competitive continuation requests
- Allowability of salaries and other project activities

- Allowability of Costs not Normally Chargeable to Awards
- Prior approval requirement waivers
- Exemption of certain procurement requirements
- Extension of financial, performance, and other reporting
- Extension of currently approved indirect cost rates.
- Extension of closeout
- Extension of Single Audit submission
