Award Mechanisms Processed by Office of Grants and Contracts Administration (OGCA)

General Characteristics of a Grant

- Assistance relationship
- PI has significant freedom to change the emphasis within the general area
- Minimal deliverables
- Benefits of the project are to the nation and world

General Characteristics of a Cooperative Agreement

- Similar to a grant
- BUT scientific or programmatic staff at the Sponsor assist with, guide, coordinate or participate in the project

General Characteristics of a Contract

- Procurement relationship
- Legally binding contract with:
 - o Detailed financial and legal requirements
 - Specific statement of work
 - o Specific set of deliverables and/or reports due to the sponsor
- A federal contract typically includes Federal Acquisition Regulations (FARs)

General Characteristics of a Subaward

Award issues from another institution (Prime Awardee) to UAF
