## Apply for Admission

Apply online <https://uaonline.alaska.edu>

Please select the **Bristol Bay Campus** for your degree campus.



## Visit ELMO

Once you have been admitted to the University you will visit <https://elmo.alaska.edu> to get your username and create a password.

You will use your UA username and password to access UAOnline, UA Webmail and Blackboard.



## Take Placement Tests

Most degree programs offered through the Bristol Bay Campus require General Education Requirements (GER's) in communication and mathematics. Registration for Communication and Mathematics courses requires a placement test.

Accuplacer placement test for Communications (Writing/English) can be taken at the Bristol Bay Campus, BBC Learning Centers, and in some regional communities.
