

#### **Key Messages:**


- Rapidly warming temperatures by Thursday night
- Accumulating snowfall increasingly likely starting Friday morning and going into Saturday morning.
  - Widespread 3" to 5" expected with some areas receiving up to 7"
- Below normal temperatures return Saturday night.
- Blowing snow will reduce visibilities to ½ mile or less on the Parks and Richardson Highway through the Alaska Range Passes.

#### Confidence:

- High Confidence: Rapid temperature changes and accumulating snowfall in the Tanana Valley.
- Medium Confidence: How quickly temperatures cool after the front passes on Saturday.
  - Cloud cover is expected to remain in the area
     Saturday, which could keep us a bit warmer.



- The heaviest band of snow is currently expected to set up south of Fairbanks.
   However, if this band moves further north, the Fairbanks area could see higher snowfall totals.
- The image on the right shows our snowfall total forecast beginning tonight through Saturday night.





# Low Temperatures Returning Next Week

- Temperatures are expected to fall rapidly beginning Sunday night and remain low throughout the rest of next week.
- The image on the right shows our minimum temperature forecast beginning Sunday night through Wednesday night.
- The lowest temperatures are expected Monday night into Tuesday morning.
