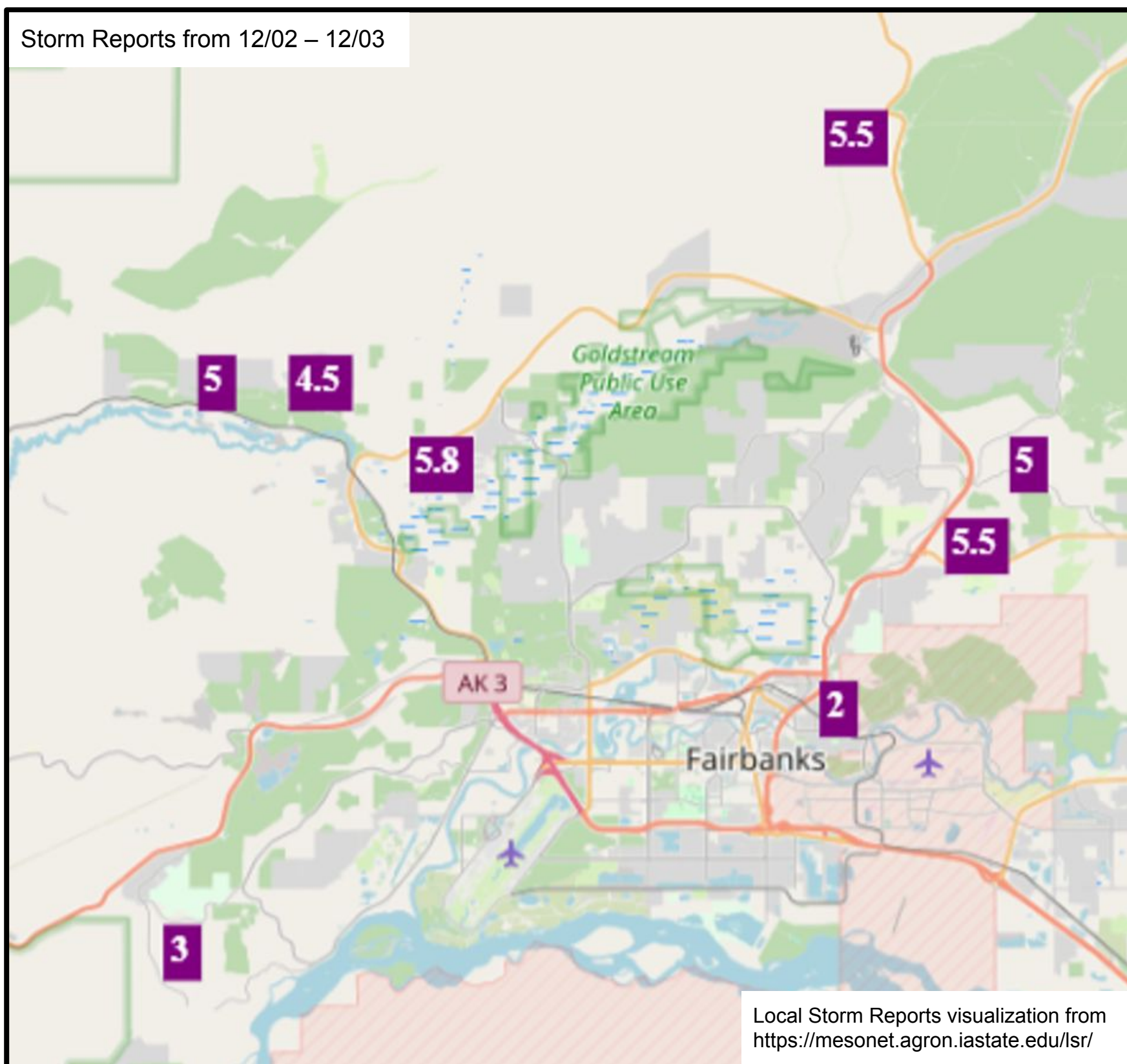


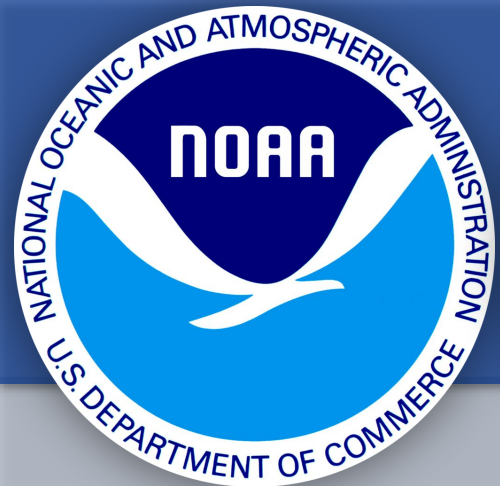


Snow Reports from December 2–3 Storm (Fairbanks area)

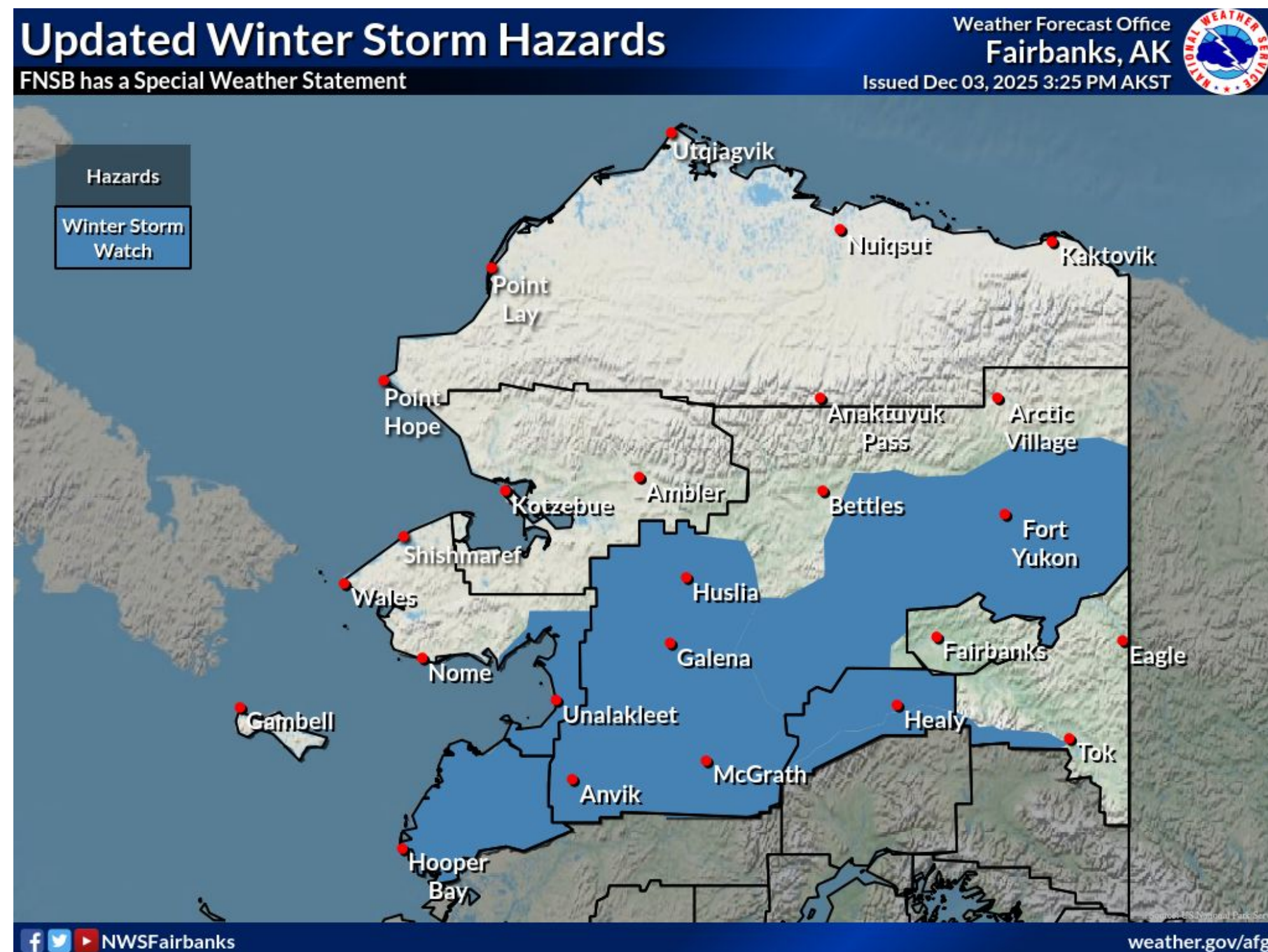

 - Prolonged cold snap expected

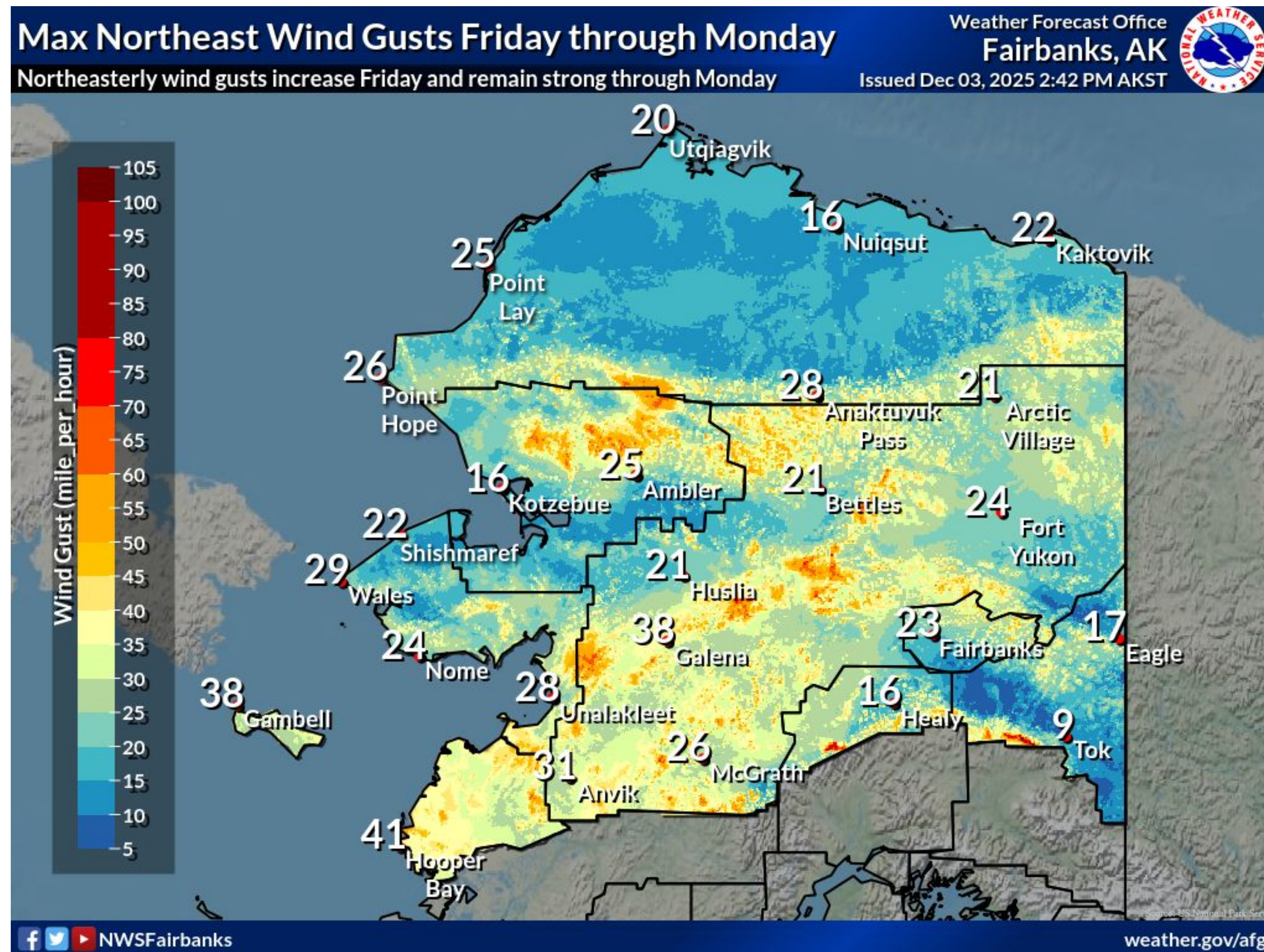
Confidence:

- **Moderate to High Confidence:** Gusty winds and dangerous wind chill temperatures
 - Blizzard conditions possible with the gusty winds and fresh snow

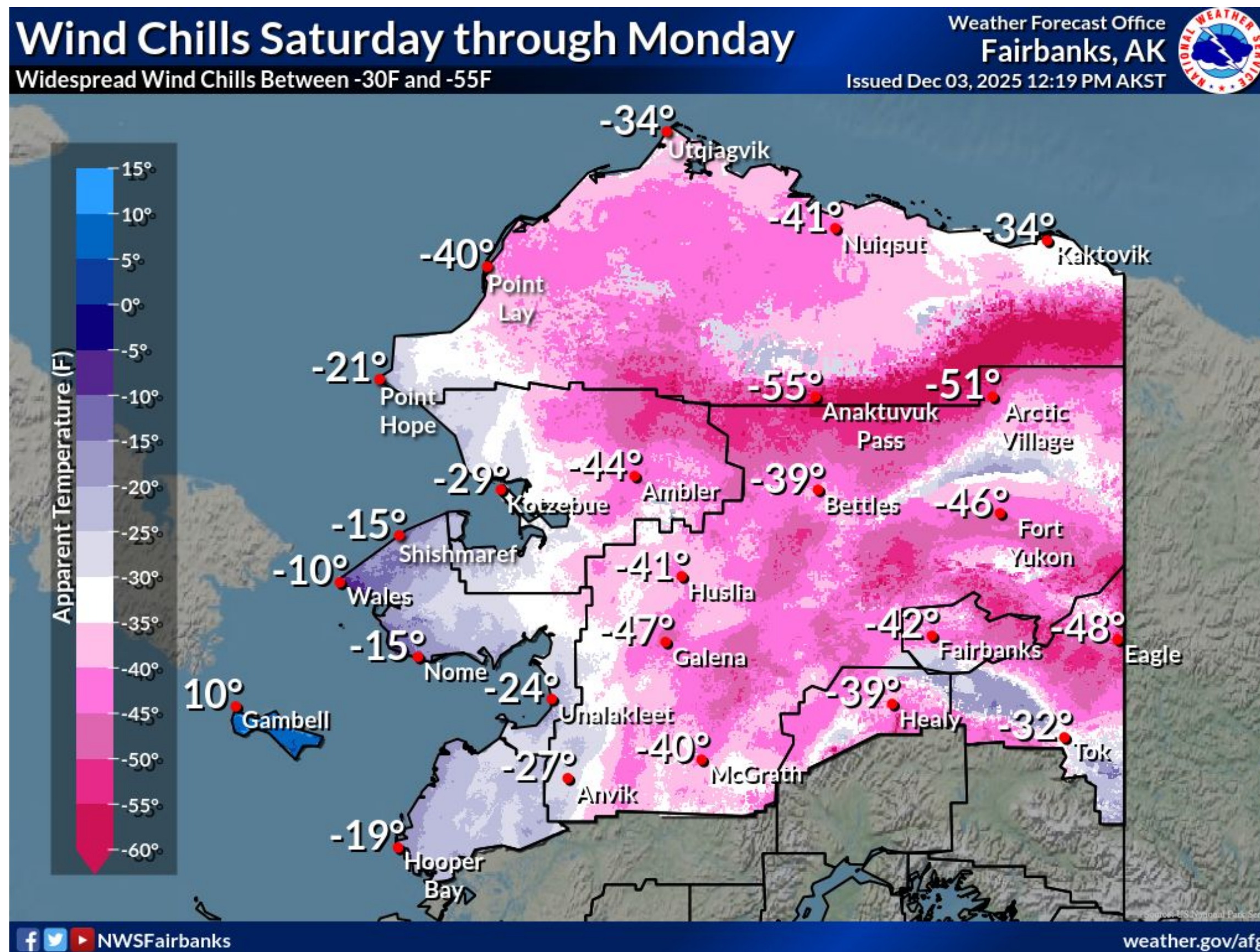
- Northeasterly wind gusts up to 50 mph are possible through the weekend. These winds could mix down to valley floors, especially north and west of Fairbanks.

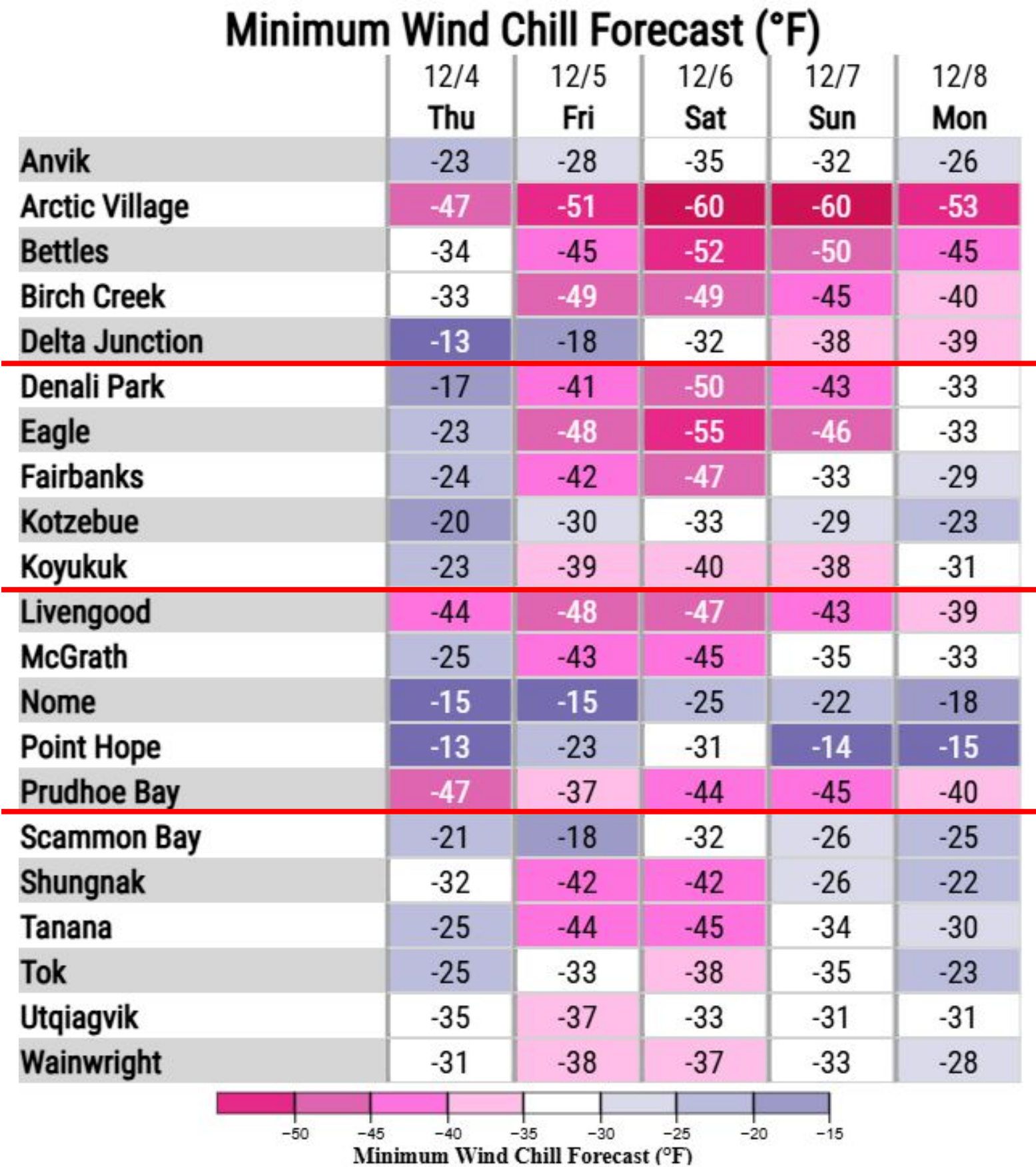
- Northeasterly wind gusts up to 50 mph are possible through the weekend. These winds could mix down to valley floors, especially north and west of Fairbanks.

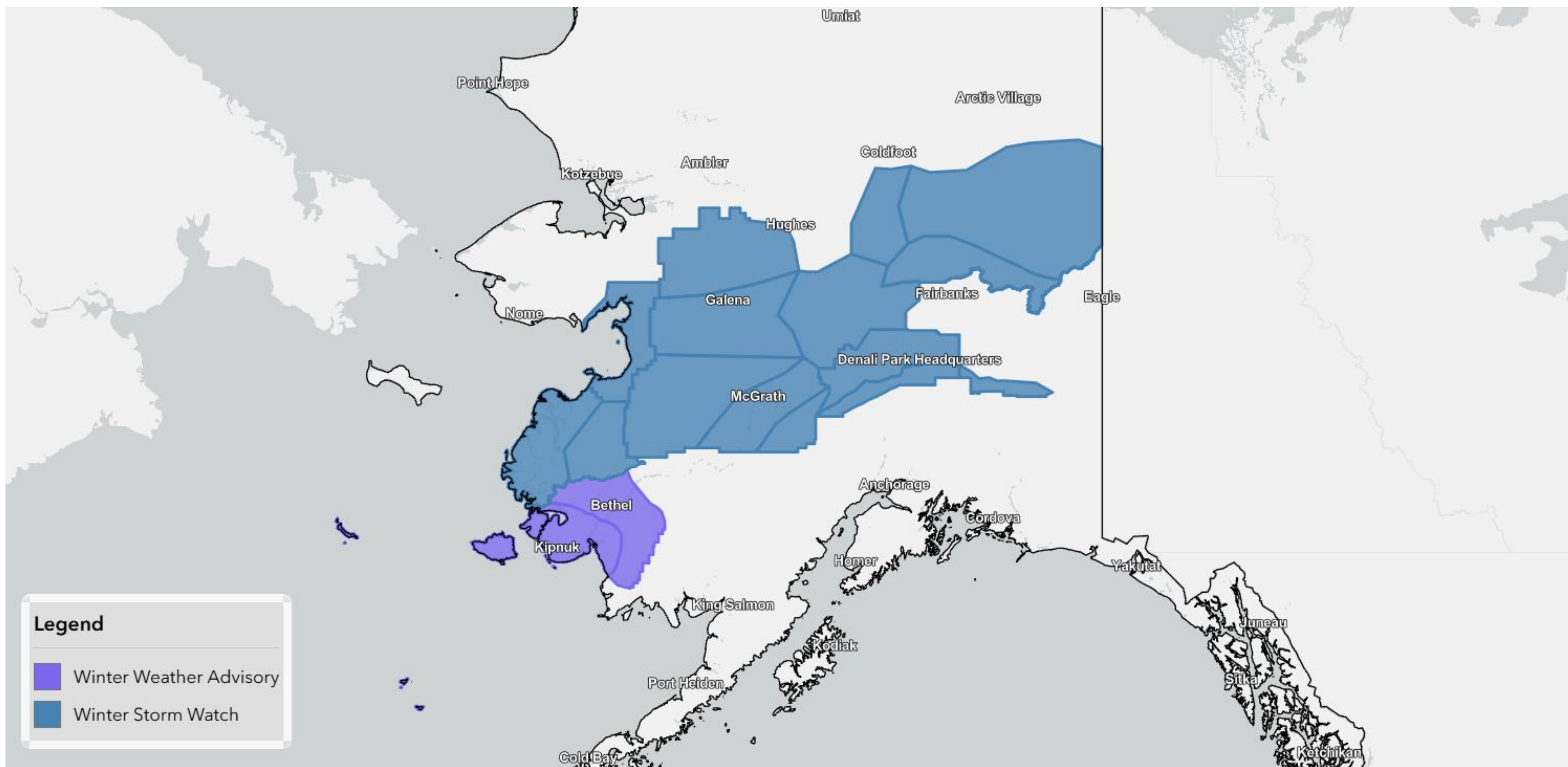
