SUPPLY LIST - Science & Sense of Place

The <u>Toolik Packing List</u> is a fantastic resource for all things clothing and gear related. We will talk more and answer any questions about gear and supplies at the pre-trip meeting in May. Binoculars - If you don't already have a pair, I strongly recommend investing in a good pair of 8x42 binoculars. I have a pair of Vortex Diamondback HD 8x42 binoculars and I love them for general use, route-finding, and especially for bird-watching. They cost about \$300 and they are very good optics for their size and weight. I wear them around my neck or on a chest harness all day without fatigue. REI has a great reference for choosing binoculars, and you can shop around locally in Fairbanks at Beaver Sports, REI, Prospector Outfitters, Frontier Outfitters, and Big Ray's. Toned Sketchbook/Notebook - Look for blank beige, grey or tan paper. I recommend looking for sketchbooks with heavier weight paper intended for mixed media. I also recommend pages that are 6"x 8" or larger for writing and/or sketching. If you don't plan to sketch, these options are all nice for writing field notes as well. Options: <u>Stillman & Birn Nova Series Sketchbooks</u> - Multiple sizes and colors, more expensive, spiral-bound options, all heavyweight paper for mixed media. Trio option includes three colors of toned paper (beige, grey, and black). • Rite-in-the Rain 8.5" x 11" Legal Pad - One size option, water resistant paper, spiral bound pad, nice cool grey tone, includes lined and blank pages so it's a great option if you prefer writing on lined paper. • Soho Open Bound Sketchbooks - Multiple sizes and colors, less expensive, best for dry media such as drawing, lays flat. ☐ 1-3 Graphite Pencils Any standard 2B pencil or mechanical pencil \$28 - Graphgear 1000 .05mm - My favorite pencil for a nice thin line and weight ☐ 1-3 Black Waterproof Pens Ultra Fine Point Permanent Marker - Works well with dry Rite-in-the-Rain Paper Sakura Pigma Micron Pens - Size 03 is the most versatile, but size 005 - 08 are all useful Additional Sketching Supplies (Highly recommended but not required!) ONE White Watercolor Pencil Any brand of watercolor pencil Caran D'Ache Museum Aquarelle - White (Smooth opaque white, tip doesn't break) ONE Black Watercolor Pencil - Any brand of watercolor pencil Caran D'Ache Museum Aquarelle - Ivory Black (Smooth deep black, tip doesn't break) ONE Pencil Sharpener - One that contains shavings ONE Kneadable Eraser - Natural rubber and won't leave microplastics behind
