Day 2 - Field Trip and Cyanotypes

- Field trip south to the Brooks Range
- Project: Botanical cyanotypes and tracings

Day 3 - Day Hike

- Optional: Day hike near Galbraith Lake, Jade Mountain, or Attigun River. If you prefer, you can remain at Toolik to rest or independently work on creative projects

Day 4 - Watercolor and Plant Studies

- Project: Basic color mixing and watercolor techniques with simple plant studies - Flex ½ day: options for a shorter outing, field sketching, rest

Day 5 - Field Trip and Tundra Study

- Field trip north to the Sagavanirktok River overlook
- Project: Mini Tundra study
- Optional: Toolik Talking Shop
