
Traveling through Fairbanks

 Staying in, and getting around Fairbanks has gotten much more expensive in recent years



"Staying in the UAF dorms was very helpful"


"We stayed in a delightful airbnb very close to the Fairbanks airport - would recommend!"

- "I did not personally (we mostly use our project truck), but there was talk around camp that TFS vehicles were limited."


Fueling trouble when at TFS

There were a few instances of confusion about how to fuel vehicles


 Projects that work odd hours or Sundays had trouble getting fuel (e.g. returning after staff work hours and needing to leave early the next morning)

Helicopters at Toolik 2024


 Helicopters in 2024 worked well, good weather helped keep everyone "on schedule"




TFS Housing



Lab Space at TFS


- "No specific issues. Prior year had a sharps disposal issue."

Shipping from TFS


- "We sent 80 tussocks south to fly back to Pennsylvania. There was limited truck space, but other than this, no problems with our shipping."
