IUSTIFICATION FOR ACTION REQUESTED The purpose of the department and campus-wide curriculum committees is to scrutinize course change and new course applications to make sure that the quality of UAF education is not lowered as a result of the proposed change. Please address this in your response. This section needs to be self-explanatory. If you ask for a change in # of credits, explain why; are you increasing the amount of material covered in the class? If you drop a prerequisite, is it because the material is covered elsewhere? If course is changing to stacked (400/600), explain higher level of effort and performance required on part of students earning graduate credit. Combining the current two courses to one will provide a clear understanding for the students and instructors regarding their time commitment to the course. All students learning the principles and methods will also take the externship as part of the course as originally intended. There will be less time spent tracking the students for their externship hours. Currently the students have up to a two year period to complete the externship hours. During this time period process is forgotten and skills become rusty. It is hard for instructors to feel positive about a student's knowledge and skills when there has been no practice for two years. Externship sites and the students will now know at the beginning of the semester the target dates for the externships. This will foster a positive relationship between UAF/CTC Allied Health and the externship sites. Students will not only complete the phlebotomy course in a more timely fashion but also be eligible to sit for the national examination within a shorter time frame. Combining the externship with the principles and methods will ensure the students are competent in their knowledge and skills when entering their externship, ensuring safer care to their clients.
