177-UNC New Course: HLTH F255 - Phlebotomy Principles, Methods and Externship, 5 credits (2+1+7); course will meet for 6 hours per week for the the first seven weeks, then followed by 100 hours of externship; prerequisites include HLTH F122 or current First Aid and CPR cards, Accuplacer reading comprehension score of 65 or above; and DEVM F060; and documentation of positive antibody titer for hepatitis B, current immunizations or titers to measles, mumps, rubella, varicella, flu shot and two step PPD within the past year; letter graded and not repeatable based upon changed content; to be offered every fall and spring; effective Fall 2013 if approved before May 2013.

175-UCDr. Course Drop: HLTH F245 - Phlebotomy Principles and Methods; course being dropped along with HLTH F265 and both will be replaced by a new course, HLTH F255; effective upon approval.

176-UCDr. Course Drop: HLTH F265 - Phlebotomy Externship; course being dropped along with HLTH F245 and both will be replaced by a new course, HLTH F255; effective upon approval.
