# A. CHANGE IN DEGREE REQUIREMENTS: (Brief statement of program/degree changes and objectives)

- 1. Course title change: THR 245 is currently undergoing a course title change from "Stage and Film Production Management" to "Stage Management" and this needs to be reflected in the degree requirements where that course is listed. This course also used to be cross-listed with Film, but Film dropped that cross listing in the current 2013-14 catalog. We need to "clean up" our listing to reflect that cross-listing change.
- 2. Directing Track fix: In the current catalog all Theatre majors take the same basic requirements and then choose a track. Each of these tracks (Design/Technical Theatre, Directing, Performance) should have 6 courses totaling 18 credits. However, we noticed a mistake in the 2013-14 catalog: the Directing track only requires 5 courses totaling 15 credits. We are now trying to fix this oversight so that it totals 18 credits like the other two tracks.
- 3. Clean up of cross-listed classes: in the Performance track, THR 347 should be listed as THR/ART F3470 because the course is cross-listed with Art. It is cross-listed in the Directing and Design/Technical Theatre tracks.

We have a new faculty hire (Brian Cook) who has stage managed professionally and considers stage management to be one of his areas of expertise; his expertise in this area was one of the reasons we hired him. This major course change needs to be reflected in the Theatre degree requirements listing.
