The department is reviewing and revising SLOA, but the plan is that student knowledge of subdisciplines, including linguistic anthropology, will be in part assessed through an exit interview for majors and minors.

G 101, "The Nature of Language" is a broad survey course of the subfields of linguistics and it does not ride an in depth of exposure to linguistic anthropology (one of the four subfields of anthropology), which part of the original intent of requiring a linguistics course for majors (as there was a long period to a tenure track linguistic anthropologist on the faculty). Furthermore, all of the other specific course the subfield in the anthropology department are taught by anthropology lty, unlike LING F101, creating a disparity in representation of the linguistic anthropology subfield. In that a course that fulfills the four-field learning outcome is now offered in the Anthropology artment, the curriculum should reflect this.
