We have made no changes to the number of credits required for the degree, nor have we substantially changed the types of courses required for students within any of concentration of the degree. The primary change that impacts all majors is the addition of a capstone requirement, which we have done in anticipation of revisions to the university's core requirements that seek to add a capstone for all students. Beyond that, we believe that, while our students have always had the option to complete a thesis project, it is worthwhile for all of them to demonstrate (either through a thesis project or through a course requiring creating a performance through collaborative endeavor) mastery of the essential skills required of artists working in professional theatre.

Further, we have tweaked the requirements for the directing concentration to better ensure that graduates have acquired skills on par with those of directors currently working in professional theatre.
