Dear Faculty Senate:

The Justice Department has been working for several years to align our model of justice education with a trend in U.S. and Alaska justice systems to be more restorative and less reliant on retribution. To this end, there are two foci pursued by UAF Justice: 1. Restorative Justice; and, 2. Alternative Dispute Resolution.

This application asks for your approval for a new minor program in Dispute Resolution (and a related change to the B.A. in Justice), which will consist of the following courses:

1. Complete the following requirements:

JUST 201, Dispute Resolution and Restorative Practices (3 Credits)

JUST 402, Dispute Systems Design (3 Credits)

JUST 403, Law and Science of Arbitration (3 Credits)

JUST 404, Clinic in Mediation, Conferencing and Circle Practices (3 Credits)

2. Complete one of the following:

JUST 320, Correctional Counseling and Rehabilitation (3 Credits)
JUST 401, Cross Cultural Conflict Analysis and Intervention (3 Credits)
"C" grade or better is required in Minor courses.

400 level courses require Junior standing, but this may be waived by the instructor. The minor can be completed in 3-4 years (see attached schedule).

It is envisioned that students from other fields (e.g. Communication, Social Work, Sociology, Psychology, School of Management, Engineering, etc.) could pursue this minor and, by petition, augment core courses with similar courses from their parent fields (i.e., COMM 330 Intercultural Conflict).

B.A. Changes:

In order to accomplish this new minor, there were a few minor course changes in the Justice B.A. that allow the Department to have the flexibility and capacity to offer the new degree. JUST F460--American Crime Control is dropped from course offerings and Justice Electives are modified to accept the new Justice courses created in the minor.

Impacts:

All courses are taught with existing staff (see attached annual schedule and staff assignments). Given this, there are no internal impacts. Related departments have been consulted and no impacts have been identified. The library holdings support this minor and the department has acquired audio, and video to supplement the library's collection.

Time Sensitivity:

As the Justice Department processed the new Minor, we also offered Special Topic Courses consistent with the new minor courses. The problem arises because several students have been taking these classes with the understanding that the minor would be approved by the time they needed to graduate. Two students schedule to graduate in May are waiting for this approval in order to have the Dispute Resolution minor on their transcripts.
