**FY14 Representation:** 7 senators and at least 4 alternates (Reapportionment has resulted in representation change. Library is now outside CLA.)

At the end of this year CLA will have 1 continuing senator and 3 continuing alternates. Both senate terms and alternate terms are supposed to be staggered. So 3-4 senators and at least 2 alternates should be elected each year. This is now out of balance for CLA.

**Senators:** Because CLA has 2 at-large seats, it is suggested that they stagger those by filling one of those as a 2-year term and the other as a 1-year term. Accordingly, one of the "topic area" seats should also be a 1-year term.

**Alternates:** CLA's practice is to have an alternate for each senate seat, and the alternate terms are staggered from the corresponding senator's term. To maintain this, CLA should elect 2-year alternates for Arts & Communication and whichever "topic area" is chosen for a 1-year senator term. CLA should elect 1-year alternates for Social Sciences and at-large. That will bring the college up to 7 alternates, properly staggered with the senator terms.
