The UAF Faculty Senate moves to form the Student Extended Leave Policy (SELP) ad hoc committee to develop policy to benefit students who need to take an extended leave.

EFFECTIVE: Fall 2018

RATIONALE: Currently, there is no Faculty Senate policy that guides faculty or students when students need to take an extended leave of absence from their coursework, e.g. for bereavement, to care for a critically ill family member, to move for military deployment, and other reasons. The ad hoc committee will work with ASUAF and student affairs personnel to craft a policy that would benefit students and act as a guide for faculty.
