MOTION Relating to the UAF Employee Tuition Waiver

We, the UAF Staff Council, are not in favor of altering the employee tuition waiver for non-represented staff as Beth Behner describes in May 3rd, 2011 email message. We are in favor of a review of this benefit and a cost/benefit analysis of the changes Beth Behner suggested in her message.
